Background

CoDesign4Transitions is a four-year doctoral network that brings together eight universities in seven countries who have recruited and supervise a cohort of 13 transdisciplinary Doctoral Candidates (DCs). The DCs carry out original research in relation to three research objectives, at the intersection of co-design, design for sustainability, service and systems design, democratic innovation and climate transitions.

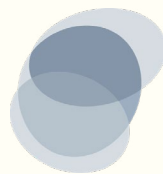

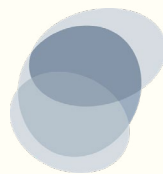
